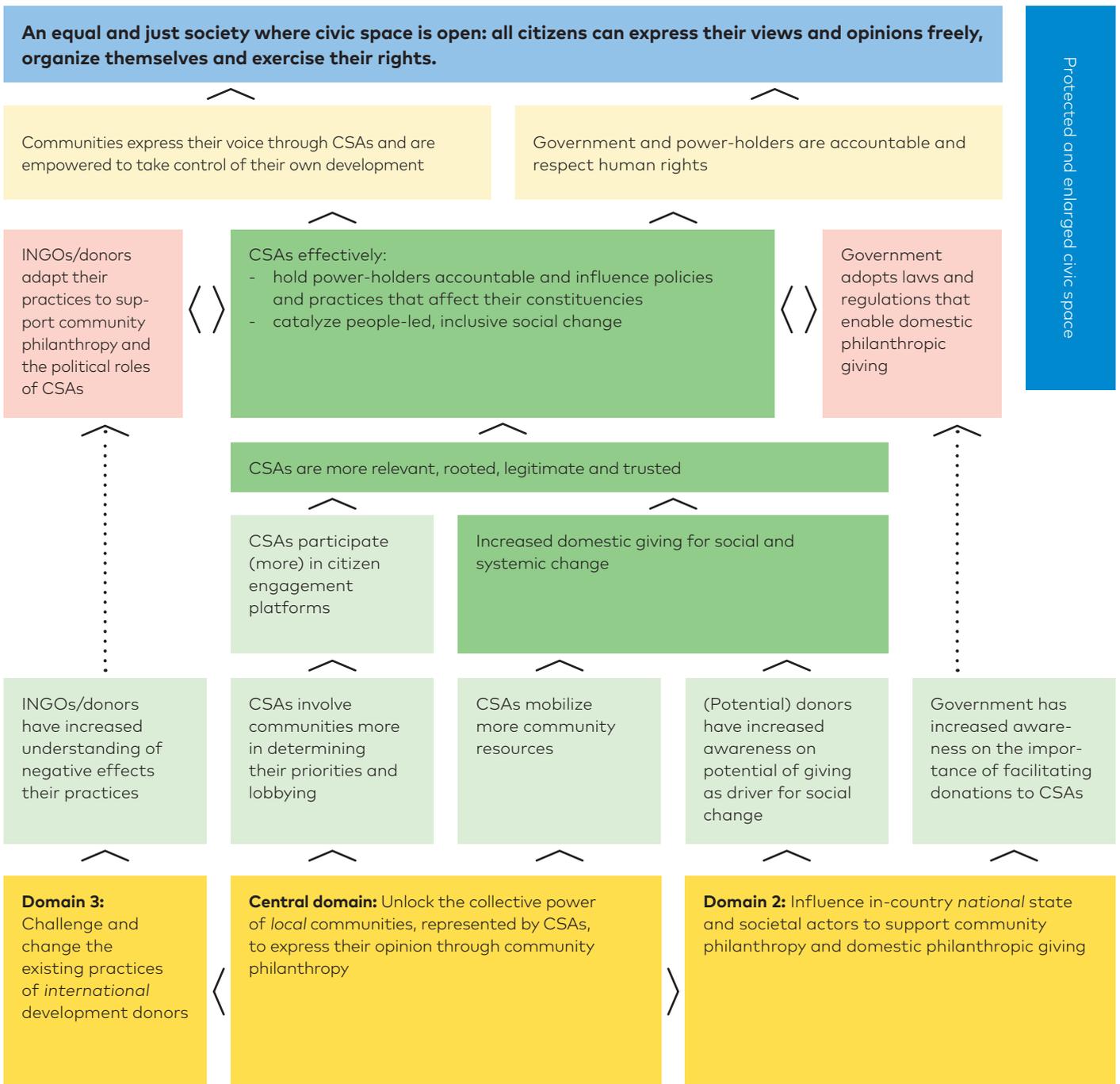


# Giving for Change
